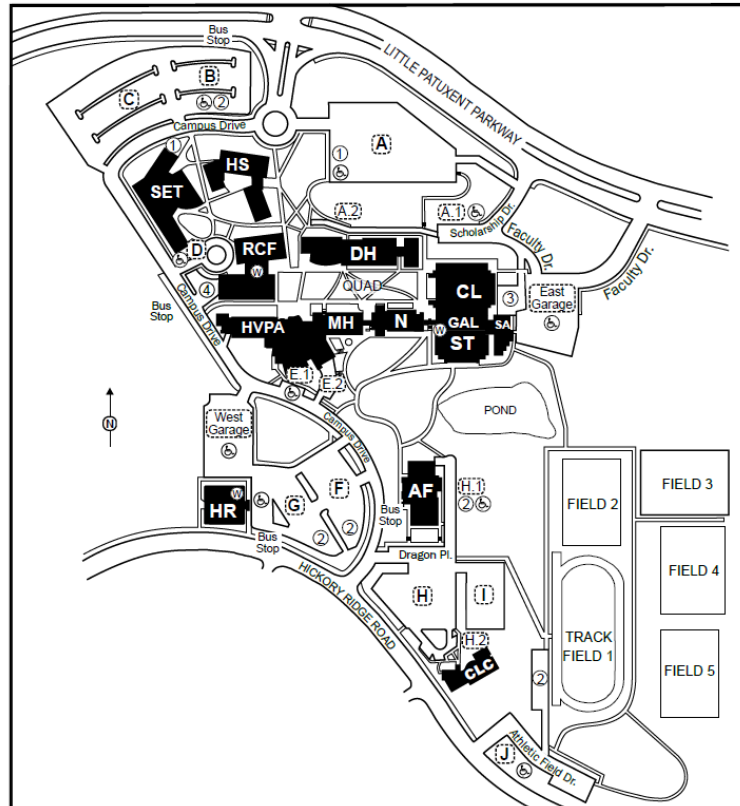

- ❑ Take I-95 South toward Washington. Take exit 38B on to MD-32 W towards Columbia. Take exit 16A on to US-29 N towards Columbia/Town Center. Take exit 18 A onto Broken land parkway. Get in Left Lane. Make Left onto Little Patuxent Parkway. College on your left.
- ❑ **From Frederick, MD and other locations west:**
  - ❑ Take 70E to Columbia. Take exit 20B from US 29S. Take Governor Warfield Parkway to Patuxent Parkway. Campus is on your left.
- ❑ **From Richmond and other locations south:**
  - ❑ Take I-495N to US-29N/Colesville Road. Stay on US-29 to Columbia. Take exit 18A towards Columbia/Town Center onto Broken land parkway. Get in Left Lane. Make Left onto Little Patuxent Parkway. College on your left.
